

COMPETITIVE TENDER No. 02/2026

For the selection of one or more operators for the provision of the universal electronic communications service for the coverage, by a public mobile telecommunications network, of 3,000 low population density localities

In accordance with the provisions of Law No. 18-04 of 10 May 2018 laying down the general rules relating to post and electronic communications and of Executive Decree No. 18-247 of 09 October 2018 laying down the procedures for managing the postal universal service and electronic communications universal service support fund, and in application of the ministerial order of 3 September 2026 setting the implementation schedule of the competitive tender procedure relating to the provision of the universal electronic communications service for the coverage, by a public mobile telecommunications network, of low population density localities, the Regulatory Authority of Post and Electronic Communications ('ARPCE') is launching a competitive tender for the selection of one or more operators for the provision of the universal electronic communications service for the coverage, by a public mobile telecommunications network, of 3,000 low population density localities.

This call for tender is intended to electronic communications network operators open to the public, holding licences for the establishment and operation of public mobile telecommunications networks.
