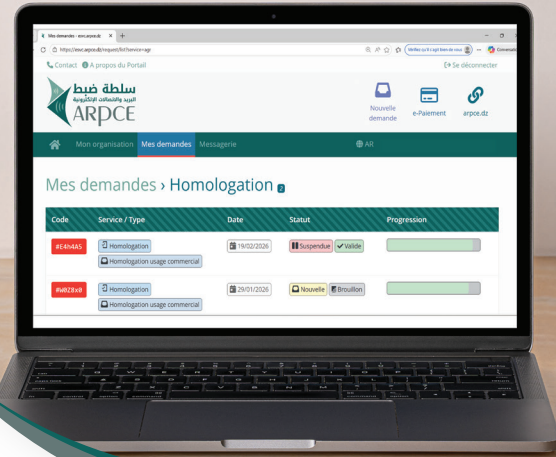




➤ Tariff

- ✔ **Administrative file** 17 500 DZD, excluding tax, payable at the time of submission of the application for approval.
- ✔ **Technical file** 150 000 DZD, excluding tax, payable at the time of collection of the certificate of conformity.

➤ Sample

- ✔ The applicant shall deposit, against a receipt, a sample of the electronic communications equipment within a period not exceeding five (5) working days from the date of submission of the application, except for equipment that is the subject of an import.
- ✔ The sample must be in perfect working order, as required for testing and measurements.
- ✔ The sample shall be returned to the applicant, upon completion of the tests and measurements, against a delivery receipt.
- ✔ The sample must bear labelling in accordance with the requirements laid down by the regulations in force.
- ✔ Where the sample, subject of the application, cannot be moved, the tests and measurements on the equipment, subject of the application for approval, shall be carried out on site within a period not exceeding ten (10) working days from the date of submission of the application.

➤ Request for Information on Approval

Applicants may enquire whether specific electronic communications equipment is subject to approval or not, online via the electronic services platform (e-services) at the link: <https://esvc.arpce.dz/>

➤ The information request file is composed of:

- ✔ An information request addressed to the Director General of the Regulatory Authority;
 - ✔ A list of the equipment concerned;
 - ✔ A technical data sheet for the equipment subject to the request.
- The list of equipment not subject to approval is also available on the website of the Regulatory Authority.

Approval and Equipment Subject to Approval

Approval is the verification of the conformity of the technical characteristics of an electronic communications equipment with the applicable standards and specifications, as provided for in Articles 9 and 10 of Executive Decree No. 26-97 of 31 January 2026, laying down the conditions and procedures for the approval of electronic communications equipment.

The equipment subject to approval by the Regulatory Authority of Post and Electronic Communications are the terminal equipment and radio installations intended to be connected to an electronic communications network open to the public.

Legal Framework

- ✔ **Article 143** of Law No. 18-04 of 10 May 2018, laying down the general rules relating to post and electronic communications.
- ✔ **Executive Decree No. 26-97** of 31 January 2026, laying down the conditions and procedures for the approval of electronic communications equipment.
- ✔ **Order No. 011** of 8 March 2026, laying down the fees for processing approval applications for electronic communications equipment.

Procedures to Follow

Submission of the Approval Application

The application for approval of electronic communications equipment shall be submitted via the electronic services platform (**e-services**):

The application must be accompanied by two files:

Administrative file:

- ✔ An official identity document for natural persons;
- ✔ An extract from the trade register for traders;
- ✔ The articles of association for legal persons not carrying on a commercial activity;
- ✔ Proof of payment of the fees for processing the administrative file;
- ✔ The commitment for the sampling of equipment for approval purposes, filled in by the applicant, where applicable.

Technical file:

- ✔ The specifications for the electronic communications equipment that is the subject of the application;
- ✔ The procedure and/or means for operating the electronic communications equipment in a laboratory, if necessary;



- ✔ The declaration of conformity of the electronic communications equipment with the recognised standards, issued by the manufacturer or by its duly authorised representative;
- ✔ The declaration of the country of manufacture, issued by the manufacturer or by any other person duly mandated by the manufacturer;
- ✔ Test reports, in electronic format, provided by an accredited laboratory, demonstrating the conformity of the electronic communications equipment that is the subject of the application with the standards specified in the declaration of conformity provided by the applicant;
- ✔ Accreditation, certified by a document issued by the accreditation body of the country in which the testing laboratory is located;
- ✔ The TAC (Type Allocation Code) certificate issued by the GSMA (Global System for Mobile Communications Association) for any electronic communications equipment incorporating a mobile cellular access functionality.
