

NOTICE OF OPEN NATIONAL CALL FOR TENDER

WITH MINIMUM CAPACITY REQUIREMENT NO. 05/DAM/ARPCE/ 2025

The Regulatory Authority of Post and Electronic Communications announces a national open call for tender with minimum capacity requirements for the acquisition, installation, and commissioning of IT security solutions.

This tender is divided into **three (03) lots**, as follows:

	Intitulé
Lot N°01	➤ Acquisition, installation, and commissioning of a Data Loss Prevention (DLP) solution. ➤ Acquisition, installation, and commissioning of a Data Classification solution.
Lot N°02	➤ Acquisition, installation, and commissioning of a Vulnerability Analysis solution
Lot N°03	➤ Acquisition, installation, and commissioning of a Privileged Access Management (PAM) solution

Bidders may submit bids for one or more lots.

I. Conditions of participation:

This tender is open to companies or firms, whether legal or natural persons, specialized in the following fields: software sales, IT services, network installation and data processing, IT security, and/or IT consulting, provided that they meet the following conditions:

Lot No. 01: Data Loss Prevention (DLP) and Data Classification Solutions

1. The bidder must have completed **at least one (01) similar service** to the subject of this lot, or **at least one (01) similar service for each requested solution** (implementation of DLP and data classification solutions) during the **last five (05) years**, supported by certificates of satisfactory performance or any other supporting document.
2. The bidder must hold a **valid partnership certificate or attestation** (Gold, Platinum, Silver, or any other form of partnership) issued by the publisher/vendor of the solutions proposed for this lot.

Lot No. 02: Vulnerability Analysis Solution

1. The bidder must have completed **at least two (02) similar services** to the subject of this lot (deployment or integration of vulnerability scanning and management solutions) during the **last five (05) years**, supported by certificates of satisfactory performance or any other supporting document.
2. The bidder must hold a **valid partnership certificate or attestation** (Gold, Platinum, Silver, or any other form of partnership) issued by the publisher/vendor of the solution proposed for this lot.

Lot No. 03: Privileged Access Management (PAM) Solution

1. The bidder must have completed **at least three (03) similar services** to the subject of this lot (implementation of PAM solutions) during the **last five (05) years**, supported by certificates of satisfactory performance or any other supporting document.
2. The bidder must hold a **valid partnership certificate or attestation** (Gold, Platinum, Silver, or any other form of partnership) issued by the publisher/vendor of the solution proposed for this lot.

Bidders who fail to provide the supporting documents relating to the above conditions will have their bids rejected.

II. Place of the terms of reference withdrawal:

III. Documents to be provided:

Offers must include an "application file", a "technical offer" and a "financial offer", according to article 13 of the terms of reference.

The "application file", "technical offer" and "financial offer", to be drawn up without erasure or overwriting, must be put in separate and sealed envelopes, indicating the name of the company, the reference and purpose of the tender and the mention "application file", "technical offer", "financial offer" depending on the case, along with the title of the lot bid for, where applicable.

The three (03) envelopes listed above must be inserted in a single envelope, sealed and anonymous, with the following statement:

IV. Duration of bid's preparation:

The duration of bid's preparation shall be **twenty (20) days** from the date of first release of this call for tender notice. If this date coincides with a public holiday or a day of rest, the duration of bid's preparation will be extended to the next working day.

V. Deadline for submission of bid:

The date for the submission of offers is set at the last day of the duration of bid's preparation, as indicated in Article 10 of the terms of reference.

If the last day coincides with a public holiday or day of rest, the date for the submission of offers shall be extended to the next working day.

(Any offer received by the contracting department after the deadline of submission of bid will be rejected)

VII. Opening of envelopes:

The commission for opening folds and evaluating bids will open the envelopes containing the application file, the technical offer and the financial offer.

It will take place on the day corresponding to the date of submission of offers, at 14:00, at the ARPCE headquarter, as indicated in Article 17 of the terms of reference.

If this day coincides with a public holiday or day of rest, the opening of envelopes shall be on the next working day.

VIII. Period of bids validity

The bidders will remain committed by their bids for a period equal to the duration of bid's preparation, as indicated in Article 18 of the terms of reference, extended for three (03) months from date of submission of bids.

In case of the retained bidder, the period of bid validity shall be systematically extended for one (01) additional month.
