

NOTICE OF NATIONAL OPEN TENDER WITH MINIMUM CAPACITY REQUIREMENTS

The Regulatory Authority for Post and Electronic Communications (ARPCE) is launching a national open tender with minimum capacity requirements for the renewal of support and licenses for IT equipment and software. This tender is divided into three (03) lots.

I. PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

This tender is addressed to natural or legal persons specialized in software sales, network installation and data processing, as well as IT consulting and engineering firms.

The bidder must hold a valid certificate or partnership attestation issued by the publisher of the solution for the lot(s) submitted, and must have carried out at least one project of similar scale to the lot(s) concerned during the last three (03) years, supported by certificates of satisfactory performance or any other valid supporting document.

Bidders who fail to provide the supporting documents relating to the above-mentioned requirements shall have their bids rejected.

II. LOCATION FOR WITHDRAWING THE TENDER DOCUMENTS

III. COMPONENTS OF THE BID

Bids must include a "candidacy file," a "technical offer," and a "financial offer," in accordance with Article 13 of the tender documents.

Each component, prepared without erasures or overwriting, must be placed in separate sealed envelopes, bearing the company name, the reference and subject of the tender, and the mention:

"Candidacy File," "Technical Offer," or "Financial Offer,"

along with the title of the lot concerned, where applicable.

These three envelopes must be placed inside a single anonymous sealed envelope, bearing only the following information:

IV. BID PREPARATION PERIOD

The bid preparation period is set at twenty (20) days, starting from the date of the first publication of the tender notice.

If this date falls on a public holiday or legal rest day, the preparation period shall be extended to the next working day.

V. DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF BIDS

Bids must be submitted on the last day of the bid preparation period, as specified in Article 17 of the tender documents.

If this day falls on a public holiday or legal rest day, the deadline shall be extended to the next working day.

No bids will be accepted after the specified date and time.

VII. OPENING OF BIDS

The opening of the envelopes containing the candidacy file, technical offer, and financial offer will be carried out by the Bid Opening and Offer Evaluation Committee.

It will take place on the same day as the bid submission deadline at exactly 2:00 p.m., at the headquarters of the Regulatory Authority, as specified in Article 16 of the tender documents.

If this day falls on a public holiday or legal rest day, the opening will be held on the next working day.

Bidders are invited to attend the public bid opening session.

VIII. BID VALIDITY PERIOD

Bidders shall remain bound by their bids for a period equal to the bid preparation period, as specified in Article 10 of the tender documents, plus three (03) additional months, starting from the bid submission date.

For the successful bidder, the bid validity period shall be automatically extended by one (01) additional month.
