



## NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL CALL FOR TENDER

The Regulatory Authority for Post and Telecommunications (ARPT) launches an national and international call for tenders relating to **Assistance to the implementation of the “Electronic certification in Algeria”**.

The tenders expected by the ARPT for this assistance can be summed up in what follows:

- To set up the necessary tools and mechanisms for the authorizations' granting, and the electronic certification service providers follow-up and control;
- To set up a model of confidence with its legal, organizational and technical components.

The interested tenderers can:

The closing date for getting the specifications is **04 October 2009 at 16 pm.**

The proposed tender must be presented in paper version and electronic one, and must be sent in two separate envelopes comprising the following files:

- The envelope bearing the inscription “**technical offer**” comprising the files indicated in the specifications.
- The envelope bearing the inscription “**financial offer**” of the fees and costs relating to the proposal.

Under penalty of nullity of the tender, the technical offer should not contain any indication of a financial nature.

The two envelopes must be separately closed in a cover bearing the following inscriptions:
